There are a number of Forward Scholarships valued up to \$5,000 each to help with formal study, skills development, employability, independence and community engagement. As a person with disability has many different needs with regard to the above, the scholarships can cover one or more of the following:

- Course/tuition/education fees for the year (February–December of the year you are applying for)
- Course excursion funds or residential expenses on campus
- Carers allowance contribution not funded by another source
- IT Requirements e.g. computer, hardware/software/programs/peripheral items
- Introductory computer-use training tailored to the specific needs of the individual
- Textbooks, reference material and supplies (such as stationery and art supplies)
- Additional support e.g. tuition, scribe and typing services
- Equipment and items required for the workplace and/or training or skills program
- Travel costs up to \$500 to cover transport costs to and from place of study/internship/programs
- Professional fees involved in career counselling, planning, resume services/interview coaching, portfolio development
- Any request for an item over \$2000 should be accompanied with a letter outlining the reason for the purchase

acholarship eligibility criteria

Forward Scholarship recipients are selected on the following criteria as defined by Forward:

- A member of Forward membership forms are available at: www.fas.org.au/get-involved/membership
- Australian citizens (or permanent residents) and residing in NSW, ACT or NT.
- Must be 16 years of age or over as per Guidelines (any exceptions will be considered on a case by case basis)
- A person with spinal cord injury or other related disability
- Appropriate level of academic record for formal study Applicants
- Provide evidence of enrolment or acceptance letter (Internship and graduate program Applicants may apply while waiting for confirmation of acceptance; with Scholarship awarded on successful application)
- Preference will be given to Applicants on a low income (please refer to 'Low Socio-economic Background Criteria' in Scholarship Guidelines)





Additional eligibility criteria

- Forward Scholarships may only cover supports which have not already been covered by the NDIS/iCare
- Successful Applicants must accept the conditions of the scholarship and agree to provide personal information relevant to assessing their ongoing eligibility for the scholarship funds.
- Scholarship payments are made on proof that the recipient maintains a satisfactory rate of progress. In cases where
 a student needs to repeat a session due to academic failure, the scholarship will be suspended until the failed
 subject(s) have been passed and the student progresses to the next session within that academic year.
- Should a student, in receipt of a scholarship, want to change their mode of study, for example from full-time to part-time, they must notify Forward in writing. This may affect their continuing eligibility.
- Should a scholarship be awarded and at some later stage it is found that the student no longer satisfies the scholarship criteria, the scholarship will be withdrawn.

Terms & Conditions of Scholarship

- 1. Applicants are required to be a member of Forward for the period of the scholarship year; membership forms can be found on the website at: www.fas.org.au/get-involved/membership
- 2. Each successful Applicant will need to provide a photo of themselves, a signed agreement form as well as a twice-yearly (in June and December) update report to Forward on the progress of their studies and how the scholarship has helped them. Forward may choose to use this material for promotional purposes.
- 3. Forward requires recipients to achieve satisfactory academic progress to continue to be eligible for the Forward Scholarships.
- 4. If the Applicant or, if the recipient of the grant is under 18 years of age, the Sponsor agrees that the details which have been entered on this application form are correct to the best of Applicant's/Sponsor's knowledge and the Applicant meets the eligibility criteria outlined in the "Guidelines for the Forward Scholarship 2024".
- 5. That the Applicant/Sponsor will advise, or cause to be advised, Forward as soon as practicable during the course of any scholarship that may be awarded, if any of the details provided in the application form change in any material degree.
- 6. The funds which Forward agrees to make available under the terms of the scholarship may be utilised only for the purpose shown in the application form, or for other purposes which may subsequently be agreed to by Forward in writing as being relevant to the purpose of the said scholarship. Payments under a scholarship will be made by Forward on the provision a tax receipt is received of full payment or alternative arrangements can be made upon request. All claims for the payment must be received at Forward by no later than 13th December 2024.
- 7. Forward reserves the right in its sole discretion to terminate a scholarship in the event that the student terminates, or fails to pursue in good faith or substantially changes the nature of the program (including the place of study) for which the said scholarship has been awarded. Further, that under such circumstances Forward shall not be further liable except for reimbursements of expenses incurred in good faith, by or on behalf of the student prior to such terminations.
- 8. Forward's commitment for any scholarship shall extend, in the first instance, from successful acceptance in February to December for the applicable year of said scholarship. Any extension of said scholarship shall be subject to continued funding by Forward and then a further application being lodged by the Applicant and being accepted by Forward at its sole discretion.
- 9. Forward may request proof of disability and access to education records relevant to this application, and make such enquiries from government or other bodies as may be considered necessary for verification of information supplied in this application; provided that Forward shall advise the Applicant or Sponsor in writing of its intention to do so
- 10. Application for a Forward Scholarship constitutes statement by the Applicant that they are of good character. Criminal offences (committed prior to or during the Scholarship period) will result in ineligibility for and termination of the scholarship.
- 11. A selection committee from Forward will choose the successful Applicants and the ongoing management of the recipient's eligibility.
- 12. That the Applicant/Sponsor has read and fully understood the "Guidelines for the Forward Scholarship 2024" and agrees to the above Terms and Conditions.
